Police Seek Public's Help Identifying Robbery Suspect

The Metropolitan Police Department, City of St. Louis ("the department") is requesting assistance from the public in identifying an individual who robbed the St. Louis Community Credit Union at 4435 Chippewa on February 24, 2010 at 2:20 p.m.

The suspect is described as a Black male who is in his 40s or early 50s, who is approximately 5'9" tall and who weighs approximately 240 pounds. He was wearing a black leather jacket, blue jeans and a brown suede western-style hat. The suspect indicated he had a weapon while committing the robbery, however no weapon was displayed. The teller complied with the suspect's demands. No one inside the credit union was hurt.
